The Aim


To improve the awareness of work-related road safety, employers' duty of care and employees' responsibilities.

The Ambition


To bring about a radical change in how organisations think about work-related road safety.

To improve the levels of compliance for all those who drive or ride for work and to demonstrate the dramatic business benefits of managing work-related road safety more effectively.




The Work Related Road Safety Challenge



Known to be significantly under reporting true scale of the problem Academic research suggest only 20% of collisions record journey purpose






- Delivering multi-agency initiatives
